T1. Belvedere Palace Combination ticket - \$32.50 per person, Daily 10:00 AM- 5:30 PM

Enjoy your visit at the beautiful Belvedere Palace, which is one of the most important cultural highlights in Vienna and offers you a variety of culturally interesting sights.

The Tour: Take the chance and visit the Belvedere Palace, the palace at the heart of Vienna and which was the baroque summer residence of the renowned general and art connoisseur Prince Eugene. In the Upper Belvedere you find the world's largest Klimt collection with the famous golden pictures "The Kiss" and "Judith" which is a "must" for Klimt fans. In this magnificent palace you can stroll past Austrian art from the Middle Ages to Gustav Klimt and Egon Schiele. And from the Marble Hall there is an unforgettable view across the Baroque palace gardens to St. Stephen's Cathedral. At Prince Eugene's Lower Belvedere and Orangery, the museum stages superb temporary exhibitions with artworks from all over the world. Here you can also discover Prince Eugene's staterooms, the Hall of Grotesques and the sumptuous Golden Room, the Palace Stables and the Privy Garden.

Or discover Jewish history and culture at first hand in the Jewish Museum Vienna. Palais Eskeles houses a permanent exhibition on Austrian Jewish history including the famous Max Berger Judaica Collection; the museum branch at Judenplatz presents a virtual tour of Jewish life in the 14th century. House of Music, an interactive sound museum, is a modern interactive experimental museum in the historic city centre as well as the location where the Vienna Philharmonic was founded. Six floors are dedicated to the presentation of the world of music and sound. Test your own musical talent on the conductor's virtual rostrum, experience the original Viennese New Year's concert in top picture and sound quality, compose your own waltz, and experiment with pitch, sounds and musical instruments.

T11. Vienna Woods and Mayerling –\$69 per person - Sun 9:45 AM

Duration of tour: 4 hours (air conditioned vehicles)

The Tour: We take you to the southern part of Vienna Woods, passing by the roman city of Baden, before we reaching Mayerling, where we visit the convent and the former hunting-lodge of Crownprince Rudolph. We continue with a visit to the Abbey of Heiligenkreuz where we will see the tomb of the Babengerd Family. Finally we will visit the 'Seegrotte' or 'Seagrotto' for a boat ride on Europe's largest subterranean lake before returning to Vienna where the tour will end at the Opera House.

Includes: Transportation by coach, entrance to the 'Seagrotte' with boat ride and a guided tour of the Crown Prince Rudolph's former hunting-lodge, the Abbey of Heiligenkreuz and the 'Koryphaeum' exhibition in Baden (afternoon only).

G1. Bratislava from Vienna by Bus with Lunch - \$62.00 per person, Daily 9:15 AM

Enjoy panoramic views from the tallest structure in Austria, the Danube Tower. Familiarize yourself with Viennese culture with a visit to a traditional wine tavern where local music and wine are abundant
